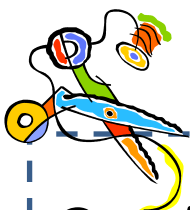
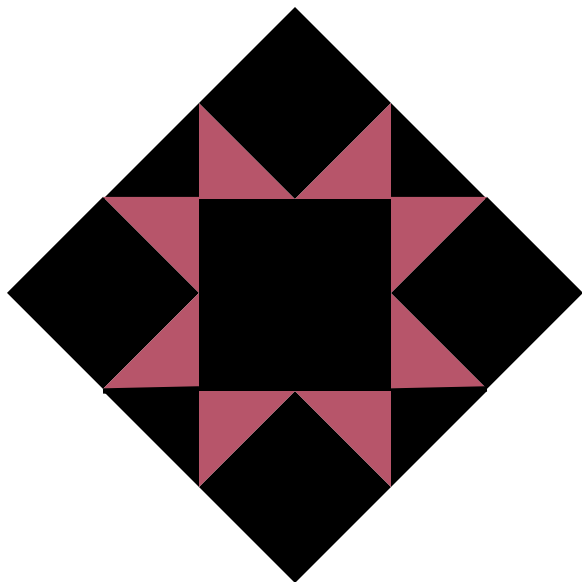
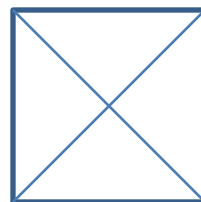


Aunt Eliza's Star

Cutting Instructions



Background (Kona black):

Cut four (4) 3 ½ inch squares

Cut one (1) 4 ¼ inch square, cut on both diagonals

Cut one (1) 4 ¾ inch square

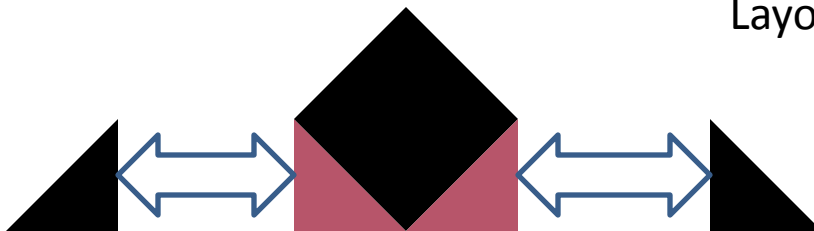
Cut on both diagonals

Batik:

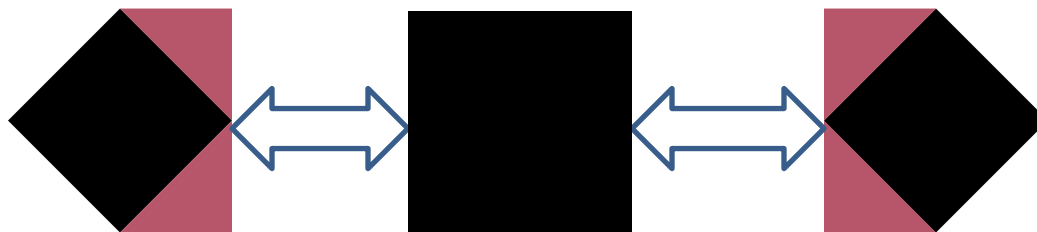
Cut two (2) 4 ¼ inch squares, cut on both diagonals

Block 1: Aunt Eliza's Star

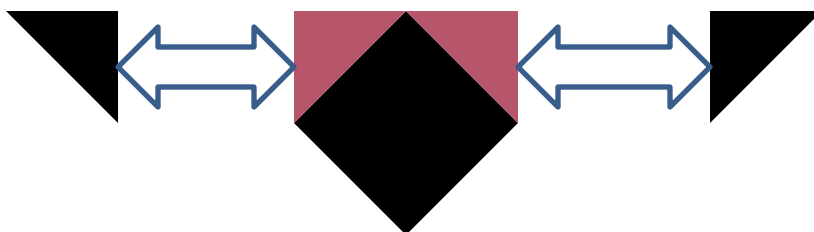
Layout Row 1

Layout Row 3



Sew 3 ½ inch squares of black to two batik triangles oriented as shown. Make four.



Sew black triangles to two of the units from step 1 as shown.



Sew a unit from step one to each side of the 4 ¾ inch black square, so it looks like row 2 in the diagram.



Using the diagram as a guide, assemble the block sewing row 1 to row 2 and then to row 3.
