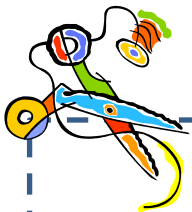
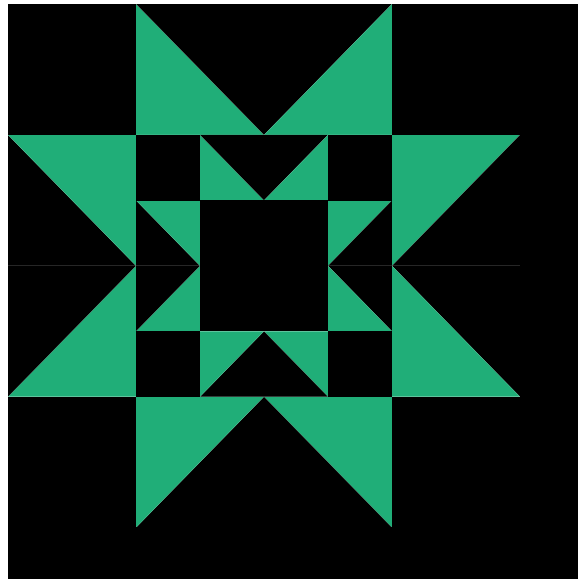


# Rising Star

### Cutting Instructions

#### Background (Kona black):

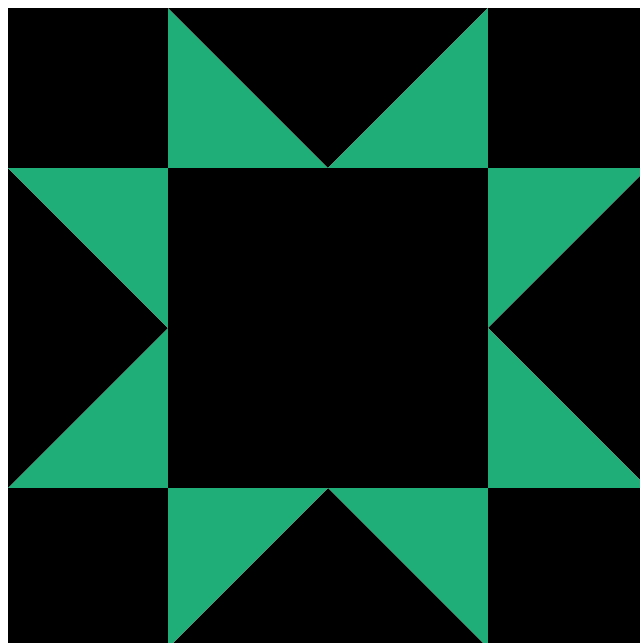
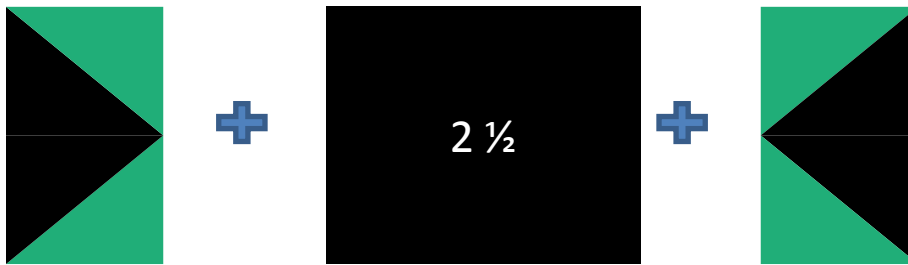
- Cut four (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- Cut four (4)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- Cut four (4)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Cut four (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Cut one (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Cut one (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ "

#### Batik:

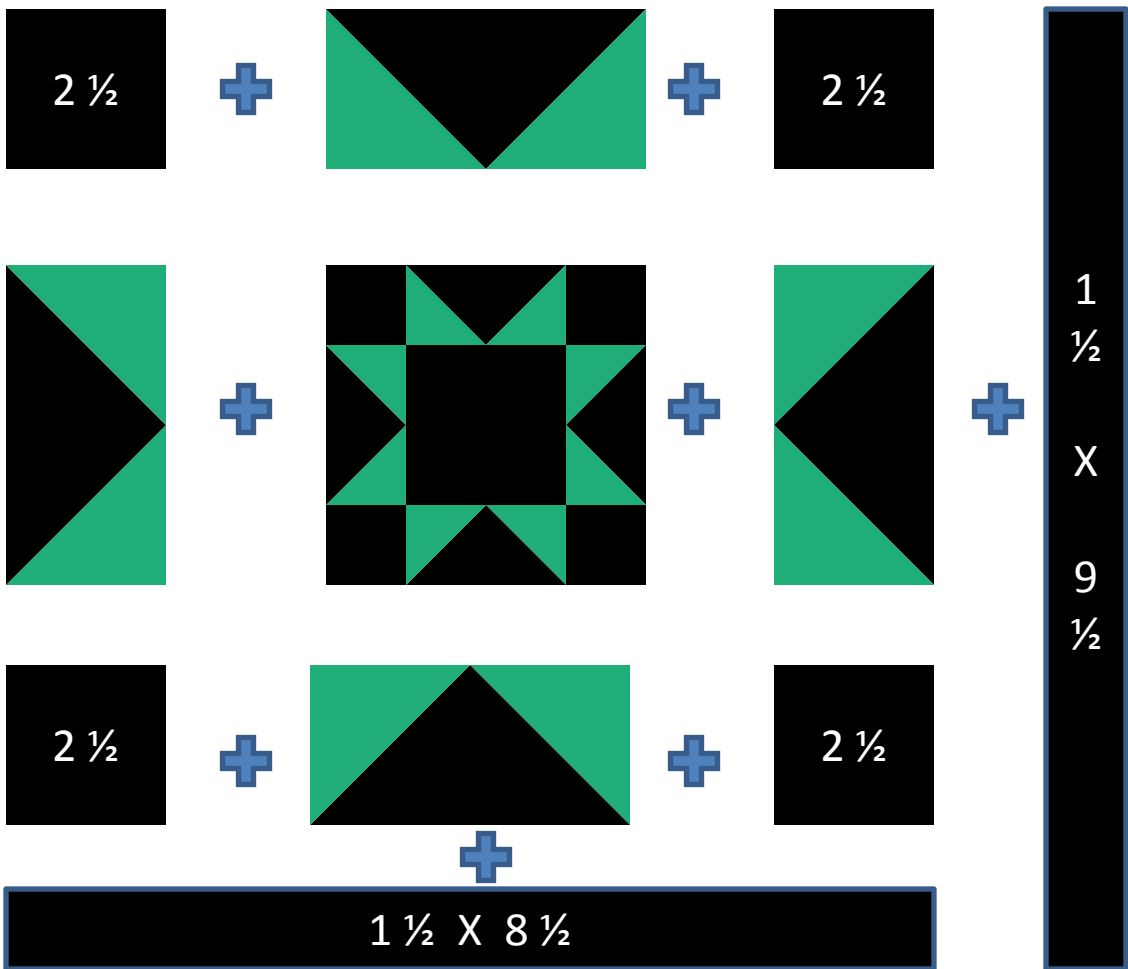
- Cut eight (8)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- Cut eight (8)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

# Block 3: Rising Star



Assemble  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " flying geese units, using any method you choose. (See files for suggested technique.)



Referring to diagram, assemble rows 1, 2 & 3.



Assemble  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " flying geese units.



Using small star as block center, assemble rows 1, 2 & 3 according to the diagram.



Sew  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to one side of the block. Then sew  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to block as shown in diagram.
