

# Cheap Change Mystery Quilt

## Fabric

The finished quilt is 48 inches by 48 inches. You will need 4 fabrics for this quilt.

**Fabric A** (Background) 2 1/4 yards

**Fabric B** (A DARK you like) 2 1/4 yards--INCLUDES binding

**Fabric C** (Another DARK you like that goes nicely with Fabric B) 3/4 yard

**Fabric D** (Sparkle--something that pops next to Fabrics B and Fabric C) 1/2 yard

Directional and striped fabrics will NOT work well in this mystery. You are welcome to post possible fabric choices and I will let you know if they will work in the mystery.

## Cutting Instructions

I would strongly recommend either putting the cut pieces in a baggie marked with the size or using sticky notes on your stacks so each size is clear when it comes time to sew. Please note some pieces require additional cutting and some additional marking. (Notice the small cutting icon or red asterisk to indicate which action is necessary.) Cutting instructions:

### **Color A**

- (3) 13 ¼ inch squares **cut twice** on diagonal
- (2) 12 ⅝ inch squares **cut twice** on diagonal
- (2) 6 ⅝ inch squares **cut once** on diagonal
- (13) 4 ½ inch squares
- (18) 2 ⅞ inch squares\*
- (32) 2 ½ inch squares\*

## Color B

- (2) 36 ½ inches by 1 ½ inches
- (2) 34 ½ inches by 1 ½ inches
- (3) 13 ¼ inch square **cut twice** on the diagonal
- (4) 6 ⅞ inch squares **cut once** on the diagonal
- (36) 4 ½ inch by 2 ½ inch rectangles
- (18) 2 ⅞ inch squares

## Color C

- (4) 6 ½ inch squares
- (16) 4 ½ inch by 2 ½ inch rectangles
- (16) 2 ½ inch squares

## Color D

- (72) 2 ½ inch squares\*

**\*Draw diagonal line on back of square.**
