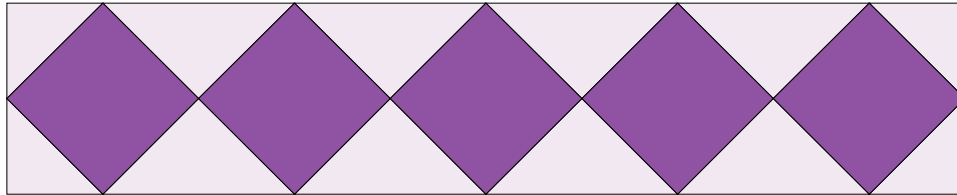


Quilty Delights

Sashing Strips




Color A (Pictured as purple):

(80) 2 inch squares

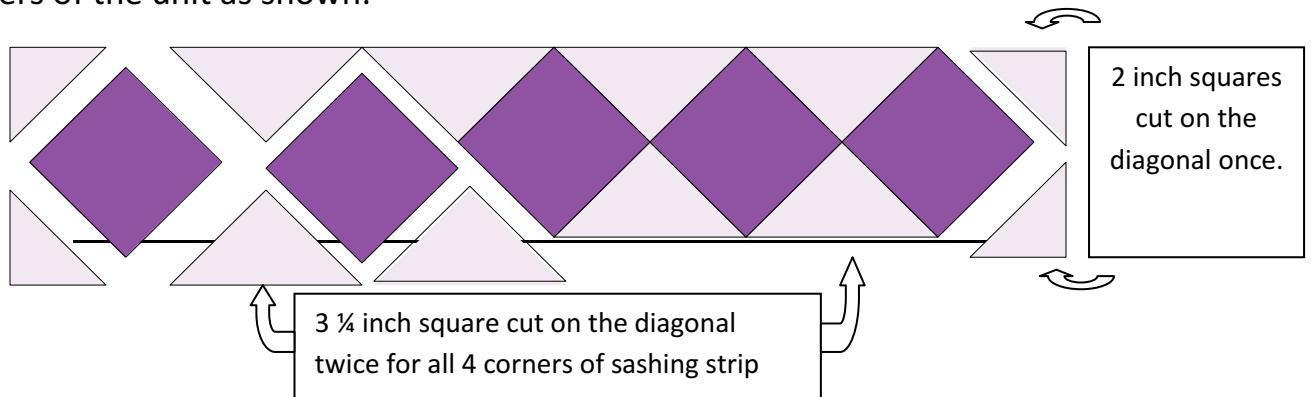
Color C (Background):

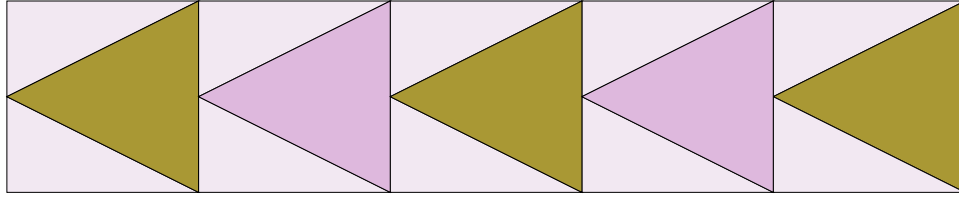
(64) 2 inch squares, cut once on the diagonal 

(32) 3 ¼ inch squares, cut twice on the diagonal 

Make 16 sashing units measuring 2 ½ inches by 10 ½ inches for Quilty Delights.

Assembly: Using three Color A 2 inch squares and six background 3 ½ inch triangles, sew a triangle to opposite ends of the squares. Using two Color A 2 inch squares and two background 3 ¼ inch triangles, sew one triangle to each square. Sew together all five square-triangle units. Add the background triangles that have been made from background 2 inch squares cut on the diagonal to the corners of the unit as shown:





Color A (Pictured as purple)

(16) 3 inch squares

Color B (Pictured as green)

(24) 3 inch squares

Color C (Pictured as background)

(20) 3 ½ by 1 ¾ inch rectangles cut on the diagonal once in this direction



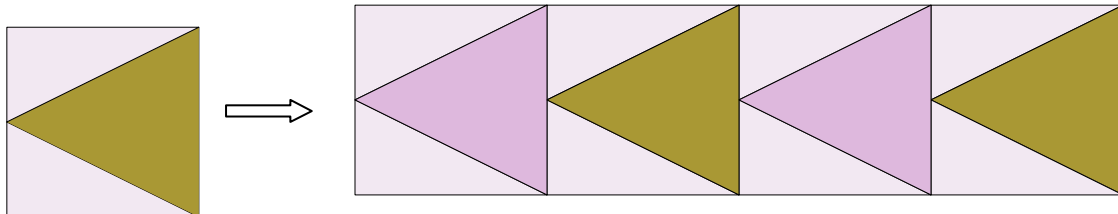
(20) 3 ½ by 1 ¾ inch rectangles cut on the diagonal once in this direction

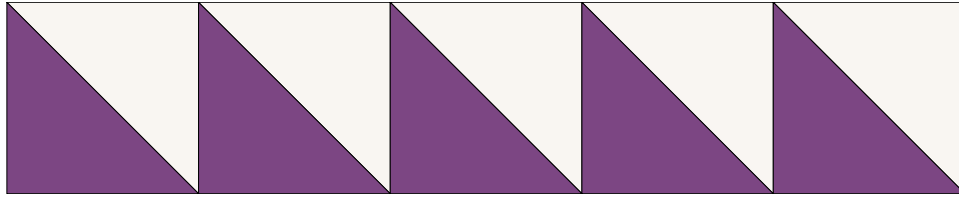


(40) Paper piece templates found at www.EwesQuilting.com

Make eight sashing units measuring 2 ½ inches by 10 ½ inches for Quilty Delights.

Assembly: Using your favorite paper piecing technique and the printed template, use the rough cut fabric listed above to make 40 units. Square up units to 2 ½ inches square. Alternate (3) Color A units and (2) Color C units to assemble the following sashing strip:





Color A (pictured as purple)

(20) 2 7/8 inch squares

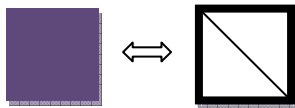
Color C (pictured as background)

(20) 2 7/8 inch squares

Make eight sashing units measuring 2 1/2 inches by 10 1/2 inches for Quilty Delights.

Half-square triangle construction:

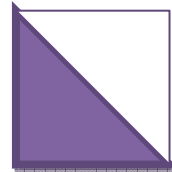
Using (20) Color A 2 7/8 inch (purple) squares and (20) Color C 2 7/8 inch squares, draw a diagonal line on the back of the lighter fabric.



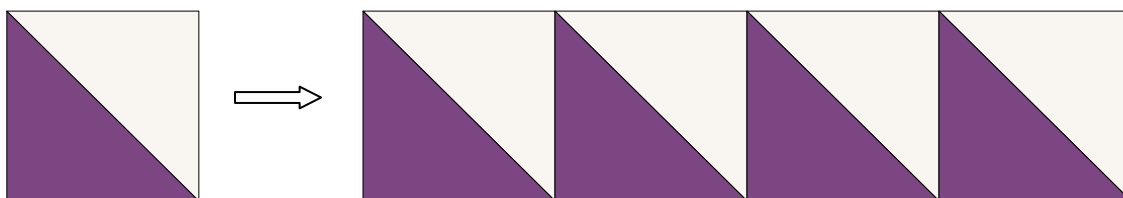
Place right sides together and sew 1/4 inch on either side of the drawn line.



Cut on the drawn line and press towards the dark fabric. You will have forty half-square triangles.



Arrange five half-square triangles as shown to create the sashing strip:



Final Assembly



Color A (pictured as purple)

(17) 2 ½ inch squares

(1) 18 ½ inch square, cut twice on the diagonal



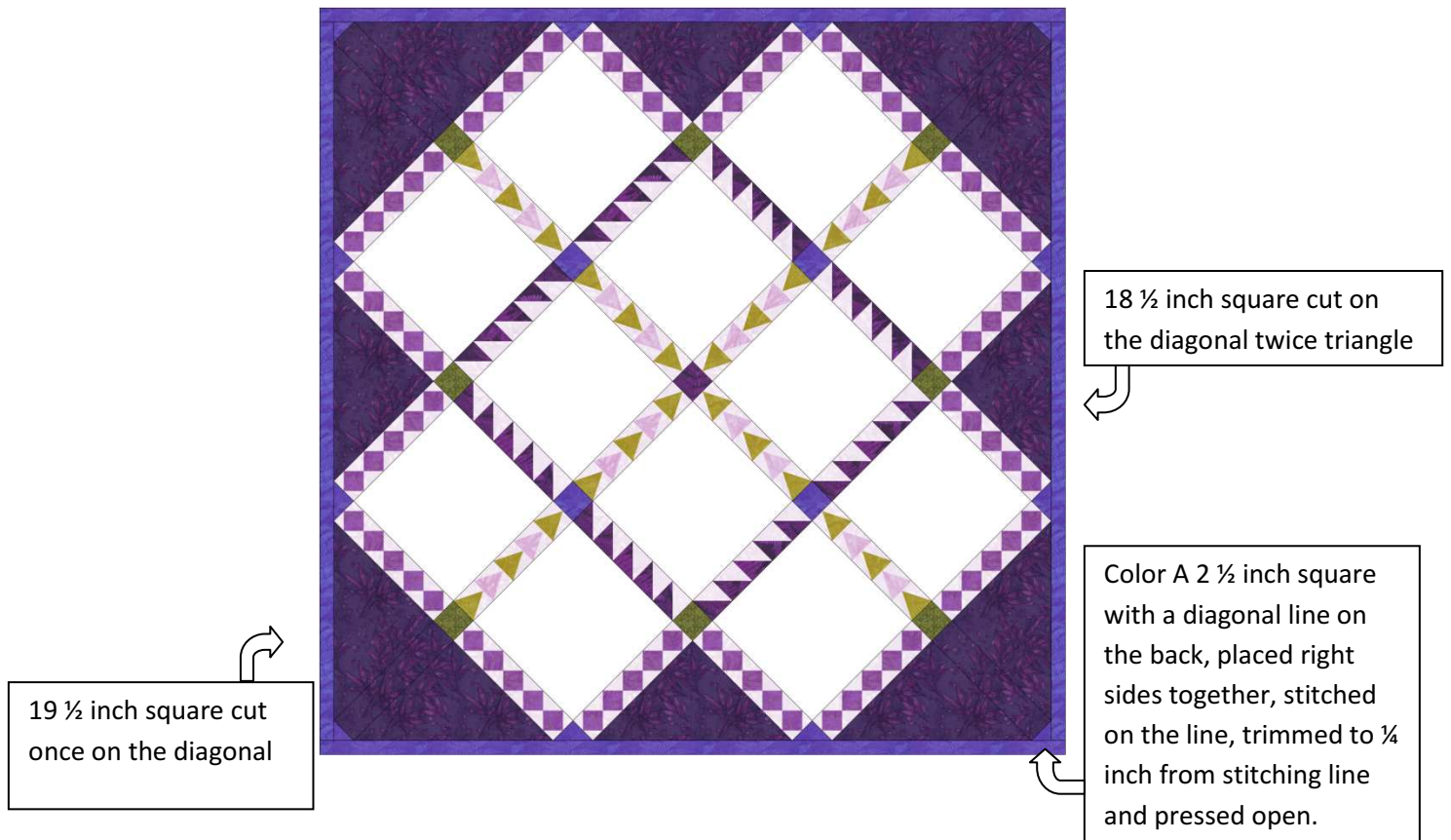
(2) 19 ½ inch square, cut once on the diagonal



Color B (pictured as green)

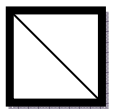
(8) 2 ½ inch squares

A little bit of fabric insurance is included in the setting triangles to allow for trimming.



Assemble quilt top in diagonal rows, taking care to put the sashing strips and cornerstones in the same position according to the diagram. You will have four Color A 2 ½ inch squares left over.

On the four left over Color A 2 ½ inch squares, draw a diagonal line on the back.



Place the marked squares on the corners of the quilt, right sides together and stitch on the line. Trim the seams and press open. When trimming, make sure to leave a ¼ inch seam allowance at the intersections so the points aren't chopped off when applying the binding. Quilt as desired, bind and label.
