

## Quilty Delights

## November Block of the Month Odd Scraps Patchwork

Cutting instructions:
Color A (Pictured as purple):
(6) $27 / 8$ inch squares (light purple)
(4) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ inch squares (dark purple)

Color B (Pictured as green):
(8) $27 / 8$ inch squares

Color C (Background):
(2) $2 \frac{1}{8}$ inch squares
(5) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ inch squares

Half-square triangle construction:
Using (6) Color A $2 \not \boxed{/ 2}$ inch (light purple) squares and (6) Color B $2 \not \approx / 8$ inch squares, draw a diagonal line on the back of the lighter fabric.


Place right sides together and sew $1 / 4$ inch on either side of the drawn line.


Cut on the drawn line and press towards the dark fabric. You will have four half-square triangles.


You should have a total of 12 AB half-square triangles.
Using (2) Color B $2 \not \approx 8$ inch (light purple) squares and (6) Color C $2 \not \approx 8$ inch squares, make a total of 4 BC half-squares triangles.

Assemble corner units:
Using one $B C$ half-square triangles and three $A B$ half-square triangles, orient the HST according to the diagram:


Make three more for a total of four corner units.

Construct block according to the following diagram:
