

## **Quilty Delights**

## **November Block of the Month Odd Scraps Patchwork**

Cutting instructions:

Color A (Pictured as purple):

- (6) 2 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> inch squares (light purple)
- (4) 2 ½ inch squares (dark purple)

Color B (Pictured as green):


(8) 2 % inch squares

Color C (Background):

- (2) 2% inch squares
- (5) 2 ½ inch squares

Half-square triangle construction:

Using (6) Color A 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> inch (light purple) squares and (6) Color B 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> inch squares, draw a diagonal line on the back of the lighter fabric.



Place right sides together and sew ¼ inch on either side of the drawn line.



Cut on the drawn line and press towards the dark fabric. You will have four half-square triangles.




You should have a total of 12 AB half-square triangles.

Using (2) Color B 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> inch (light purple) squares and (6) Color C 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> inch squares, make a total of 4 BC half-squares triangles.

Assemble corner units:

Using one BC half-square triangles and three AB half-square triangles, orient the HST according to the diagram:



Make three more for a total of four corner units.

Construct block according to the following diagram:
